Officer Sean Wilson of the Brattleboro Police Department rented an apartment from Lorenzo Deconinck for an unknown period of time but as recently as 2017.

In March of this year, Lorenzo Deconinck was indicted by the federal government for conspiracy to distribute cocaine and possession to distribute cocaine in violation of 21 U.S.C. §846.

It has been reported that Officer Wilson wrote "for cocaine" on rent check(s) provided to Deconinck, and that Officer Wilson observed Deconinck with cocaine and being under the influence of cocaine. My office is not aware of Officer Wilson reporting any illegal activity on the part of Lorenzo Deconinck to any law enforcement authorities.

It has also been reported that Officer Wilson provided information to Deconinck and his associates regarding police investigations.
