The following is excerpted from a summary issued on Sept. 23, 2020 by the Rutland County State's Attorney's Office of police officers with Giglio issues/disclosures since 2015.

Ed Dumas, Rutland Town Police Department: while an officer at Rutland City Police Department, Dumas did not charge a group of juveniles who had egged a house. He, with the support of the homeowner, allowed the juveniles to work off the damage on their own. One of the juveniles is the child of a RCPD officer. When one of the juveniles disputed the costs of the damages, the homeowner changed his mind and wanted to pursue charges. Dumas was disciplined for not having the case in the RCPD's data system.
